- Do not make mass installation before testing.
- Installer must affix a warning label to the fixture, which annouces the fixture has been altered.


- Risk of electic shock.

- If the lamp or luminaire exhibits undesirable operations (buzzing, flickering) immediately turn off power, remove the lamp.

### **PLUG AND PLAY & DIRECT WIRE**






## **Plug and Play Installation**



- **1.** Turn off the power to the light fixture at the breaker panel before the installation.
- 2. Open the diffuser from the light fixture.
- **3.** Remove the flourescent tubes. Dispose of these items properly as they may contain mercury.
- **4.** Install the LED tubes and close the diffuser.
- **5.** Turn on power.

### **Direct Wire Installation**



- **1.** Turn off the power to the light fixture at the breaker panel before the installation.
- 2. Open the diffuser from the light fixture.
- **3.** Remove the flourescent tubes. Dispose of these items properly as they may contain Mercury.
- **4.** Cut the wires shown, remove the ballast.
- **5.** Connect wires to sockets according to the diagram below.
- **6.** Install the LED tubes and close the diffuser. Turn the power on.
